Activity 1 - Stakeholder Identification

- Develop Project Website
- 1st Public Involvement Meeting
- Development of Community Advisory Group (CAG)

Activity 2 - Develop Purpose & Need Statement for the Project

- Community Advisory Group (CAG) will develop a problem statement
- Project Study Group will take input and develop a formal Purpose and Need Statement

Activity 3 - Analysis of Alternatives and Selection of Preferred Alternative

- Project Study Group will develop preliminary alternatives
- Community Advisory Group (CAG) will provide input for alternative development
- Alternatives will be displayed at the second public involvement meeting for input
- Project Study Group will select a "Preferred" Alternative
- Preferred alternative will be presented back to the community at a final public involvement meeting

Activity 4 - Approval of Final Alternative

- Completion of:
 - Environmental Documentation
 - Phase I Design Report
